

## FRUIT TREE SPRAYING MADE SIMPLE

To increase effectiveness of all of the listed sprays, apply with  
**Turbo Spreader Sticker** at the rate of 1 Tablespoon per gallon of spray.

WHEN	SPRAY	AMOUNT	REASON
<b>Fall</b> (as soon as all of the leaves fall off)	<b>Liquid Copper*</b>	1-4 Tbs / gallon. Follow directions for type of tree.	Helps control bacterial blights, leaf curls, and other fungal diseases. Spray the ground and tree thoroughly.
<b>Winter</b> (when trees are dormant-Super-Bowl Sunday)	<b>Liquid Copper*</b>	1-4 Tbs / gallon. Follow directions for type of tree.	Helps control bacterial blights, leaf curls, and other fungal diseases. Spray the ground and tree thoroughly. Do not mix with oil.
<b>Winter</b> (when trees are dormant-Super-Bowl Sunday)	<b>Spray Oil</b>	5 ounces/gallon	Kills overwintering insects and certain disease spores on dormant trees. Do not mix with liquid copper. Apply when temperature is above 40° F.
<b>Spring 1</b> (when buds start to swell)	<b>Liquid Copper*</b>	1-4 Tbs / gallon. Follow directions for type of tree.	Helps control bacterial blights, leaf curls, and other fungal diseases.
<b>Spring 2</b> (7 days after Spring 1 application)	<b>Liquid Copper*</b>	1-4 Tbs / gallon. Follow directions for type of tree.	Helps control bacterial blights, leaf curls, and other fungal diseases.
<b>Spring</b> (after 2/3 of the flower petals have fallen)	<b>Fruit Tree Spray, Eight (Permethrin,) Orchard Spray or Capt. Jack's</b>	as stated on label	This application of an insecticide helps prevent insects from attacking the fruit and trees.

\*For trees with seeded fruit, (Apples, Pears, Asian Pears etc) **Lime Sulfur** can be used to control fungal diseases instead of Liquid Copper if desired.

The above basic applications should control the most common diseases and insects affecting fruits. If other problems should occur, here are some suggestions of sprays to use:

**Fruit Tree Spray** (Captan, Malathion and Carbaryl) - controls both insects and diseases.

**Eight** (Permethrin) - controls insects.

**Fung-onil** (Chlorothalonil) - controls diseases. Can be used as a dormant spray on peaches for leaf curl.

**Orchard Spray** (Sulfur and Pyrethrins) - controls insects and diseases naturally - great for organic gardening.

**All Seasons Spray Oil** - controls insects naturally - great for organic gardening.

**Captain Jack's Dead Bug Brew** (Spinosad) - controls worms, caterpillars and borers naturally - great for organic gardening.

**Traps** - for apple maggot and codling moth.

**Liquid Copper, Spray Oil, Lime Sulfur, Orchard Spray and Captain Jack's Dead Bug Brew are all natural sprays and can be used in organic gardening.**
