Bluejay	Northern highbush. Upright and open. 4'-6'.	Very large	Good pollenizer for Bluecrop	Mid July	Brilliant red and yellow.	High quality berries with outstanding dessert flavor.
Chandler	Northern highbush. Slightly spreading. 5'-7'.	Largest	See above	Late July through August	Wine & orange.	World's largest blueberry. Best fresh or as dessert.
Darrow	Northern highbush. Upright. 4'-6'.	Very large	See above	August	Orange to red.	Memorable robust flavor.
Duke	Northern highbush. 4'-8'.	Medium	Self-fruitful but best with Jersey	Early to mid July	Orange to burnt yellow.	Use for baking and eating fresh. Full, rich flavor.
Earliblue	Northern highbush. Upright. 4'-6'.	Medium to large	Self-fruitful but better with Bluecrop.	Early July	Red to burgundy.	First to ripen and early to bloom. Attractive red stems in winter.
Jersey	Northern highbush. Tall upright. 6'-8'.	Medium	See above	Mid August	Orange	Great for baking, freezing and jam.
Patriot	Northern highbush. Open spreading. 3'-5'	Large	See above	Mid July	Fiery red, yellow, and orange.	Highly flavored. Great for fresh eating, canning, and freezing.
Pink Lemonade	Vigorous & Upright. 4'-5'.	Medium	See above	Mid July to Mid August	Yellow to bright orange	Great for borders. Year-round interest.

Top Hat	Dwarf lowbush. Globe habit. 1'-2'.	Small	See above	Mid July	Fiery red.	Great for low borders and containers. Good for bonzai.
Toro	Northern highbush. Upright & stocky. 4'-6'.	Large	See above	July	Crimson red to yellow.	Outstanding ornamental quality. Great for baking. Bronze color in spring & attractive red stems in winter.
